<i>Toastmaster of the Year</i>	# ❖ Fall	Selected by the District Governor from Area Governors' submissions of their Area Toastmaster of the Year winner's names and form 1113 worksheets. Clubs submit by 6/30 to Area Governor - 7/10 to Division Governor - 7/15 to District Governor. Previous recipients and current DEC members are ineligible.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Area Governor of the Year</i>	Fall	Selected by the District Governor. Given annually to the Area Governor who makes the most outstanding contributions to the District goal achievement. Suggested guidelines are in the District Leadership Handbook.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Division Governor of the Year</i>	Fall	Selected by the District Governor. Given annually to the Division Governor who makes the most outstanding contributions to the District goal achievement. Suggested guidelines are in the District Leadership Handbook.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Al Ferguson Memorial Outstanding Club Award</i>	Fall	This award is presented to the <u>clubs</u> attaining 10 out of 10 Distinguished Club Program points in the previous Distinguished Club Program year.	Ribbon & Certificate
<i>Allan E. Seavey Memorial Membership Award</i>	Fall	This award is presented to the member who enrolls the greatest number of new, reinstated or dual members in any one year. District Lt. Governor of Marketing determines from June 30th TI World Headquarters' Report.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Bill Chase Interclub Visitations Trophy</i>	# ❖ Spring	Presented to a <u>club</u> with the most interclub visits. Donated by Bill Chase to encourage members to visit other clubs thereby broadening their horizons. Submit total club points to the Area Governor by April 10th, to be forwarded by April 30th to the District Governor or his/her designated representative.	Certificate
<i>David R. Rosvall Memorial Award For Continuous Service to District 45</i>	Spring	This award is presented to an outstanding Toastmaster for meritorious service to District 45 and beyond. This selection is made by the Past District 45 Governors, the IPDG is responsible for coordinating the selection process. Nominee must be an active Toastmaster, involved in District 45 activities, not a current District Officer and not a past recipient.	Plaque - Lrg - Spring Plaque - Keeper - Fall
<i>Malagash Trophy</i>	Spring	This trophy is awarded to the <u>home club</u> whose members attending the conference accumulate in aggregate the greatest distance traveled. Each member must attend all events at the conference. The award is based on kilo persons per club (also known as kilo toasts - the number of members present times the number of kilometers traveled). The LGM in cooperation with the Conference Chair is responsibility for selection.	Trophy
<i>Otto Peter Memorial Club Newsletter Award</i>	# ❖ Spring	District PRO should use TI guidelines, (Published in booklet 1156) for selection of District 45 recipient. Electronic Club Newsletters are eligible for this award. Submit 3 issues to the District Public Relations Officer by March 31st.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Ted Nichols Membership Retention Award</i>	Spring	This award is presented to the <u>club</u> receiving the most member retention for the October and April reporting periods as measured by the Distinguished Club Program Report. In the case of a tie, the award will be given to the club with the greatest number of members in the club.	Plaque & Certificate
<i>Terry Chinnery Memorial Membership Award</i>	Fall	This award is presented to the <u>club</u> having the highest net increase in members for the time period of October 11 through October 10 of the current year. Multiple awards are possible.	Banner Ribbon & Certificate
<i>Best District 45 Club Website Award</i>	Spring	Selection is by the PRO. Selection criteria to be developed by the PRO and District Webmaster based on the issued TI Guidelines. Period covered should be July 1 through March 31st.	Certificate
<i>Spirit of Success Award</i>	Spring	Selection(s) to be made by the District Governor. Suggested selection criteria may be obtained from TI packet # 1211 "Spirit of Success Award"	Certificate
<i>Communication and Leadership Award</i>	Spring	This award is the District's opportunity to recognize someone outside Toastmasters for contributions to communication excellence. This recipient is selected by the District Governor.	Plaque
